



Scott Bradley Holland

July 11, 1955 - April 8, 2021

Scott Bradley Joseph Holland, a resident of Shelby Township, passed away on April 8, 2021 at the age of 65.

Scott leaves behind his bride of 43 years, Karen (Schroeder), and his devoted family. His children William (Kelly), Peter (Wendy), Rose (Dan) Barney, and granddaughter Audrey gave him his greatest joy.

Scott was big brother to siblings Brian, Craig (Pam), and Judy (Jeff) Atkins. He was brother-in-law to Cindy and Clay Cprek; John and Diane Schroeder; Fred and Cathy Schroeder; Patricia Schroeder; and Jay and Lynda Schroeder. He looked forward to time spent with all of his nieces and nephews. He relished watching them grow into adulthood, marry and start their families. He was predeceased by his parents Donald and Ruth (Varga) Holland.

If wealth were measured in friendship, Scott was a rich man indeed! He had friends far too numerous to count and he especially treasured his relationship with those on "The Chivas Side of the Family". He delighted in watching the bonds of that legendary campfire circle pass on to the next generation.

Scott lived most of his life in Shelby Township, Michigan. As a youngster, he loved wandering the community to fish, search for frogs, explore, play pick up games, and shoot model rockets. He was an avid reader and a dreamer with an animated imagination. Throughout life, much of that stayed with him. As Shelby Township grew, he enjoyed being part of "firsts". After third grade, Scott transferred from Ewell to Switzer Elementary as a member of that schools' first fourth grade class. Scott met Karen in Shelby Junior High and they remained good friends for the next six years. Scott, along with wife Karen was a member of the first graduating class of Eisenhower High School. They both were there when President Nixon dedicated the school. Scott was a part of many firsts at Eisenhower including the football and track teams. He was among the school's first inductees into the National Honor Society.

It was at the end of the second year of college when Scott began to date Karen. It did not take long for him to decide he wanted to spend the rest of his life with this dear friend at his side. A few months after graduation they wed and moved to the suburban Chicago. They went on to raise a family Scott passionately loved and their marriage grew stronger with each year that passed.

Scott pursued higher education at two institutions, first at Michigan Technological University where he earned a BS in Electrical Engineering. Then on to Oakland University where he earned a MS in Industrial Engineering. He was registered with the State of Michigan as a Professional Engineer, a member of the ITW Patent Society and a past member of The Engineering Society of Detroit. His career, spanning 44 years, took him into factories around the world. He began his career with Underwriters Laboratories, then moved on to Ford Motor Company, Balance Engineering (originally a division of General Motors), and finally Dominion Technologies. He recently quipped with co-workers that he wanted his new corporate email address to list him as "Master of the Balance Universe"! His love of reading, his animated imagination, and his attributes as a team player helped him partner with other creative peers to develop five patents for three of those companies. On March 19, 2021 he spent his final day doing the work he thoroughly enjoyed with a phenomenal team of co-workers he had come to deeply love like family.

Scott's greatest works may not have been the ones that provided support of family or created patents for employers. They were the ones, rooted in service to God, that benefited the greater community. As a convert to Catholicism, he lived a deep Christ centered faith that permeated all he was and all he did. His children and their activities were a priority he worked to support. Additionally, Scott and Karen engaged in volunteer activities that focused on developing young people in the community. They gave of themselves as youth ministers, church nursery organizers, BSA - Boy Scout/Cub Scout / Venture leaders, Archdiocese of Detroit CYO Committee on Catholic Scouting Religious Medals facilitators, Parents Club volunteers at Notre Dame Preparatory/Marist Academy with focus on the fine and performing arts, and more than can be listed. Scott's personal passions included camping with family and friends, hiking amazing terrains, and organic gardening. He took great delight in growing many of the vegetables Karen cooked with.

Scott loved growing in the knowledge and practice of his faith. He, along with Karen, participated in Marriage Encounter, various bible studies, Alpha, and more. He enjoyed male fellowship at men's days of reflections and took his young sons to "Home Plate" at the old Tiger Stadium. He spent his last week participating in the Divine Mercy Novena. Even in illness, he was able to pray with Karen on Days 1 through 6. On day 7, Karen and the children prayed it at his bedside.

THIS WAS THE FOCUS OF THAT DAY'S PRAYER: Today bring to Me THE SOULS WHO ESPECIALLY VENERATE AND GLORIFY MY MERCY,* and immerse them in My mercy. These souls sorrowed most over my Passion and entered most deeply into My spirit. They are living images of My Compassionate Heart. These souls will shine with a special brightness in the next life. Not one of them will go into the fire of hell. I shall particularly defend each one of them at the hour of death.

Shortly after the prayers his pastor arrived and gave him Last Rites. As they were completed Scott, with family gathered round, quietly returned to God. It was a little after 3 pm which is the hour of mercy! It was the beautiful completion of a life well lived.
