Alta "Darlyne" Hummon, 87, of Northville, formerly of Birmingham and Beverly Hills, passed away on September 20, 2018 in Alma, Michigan.

A memorial service will be held at Masonic Pathways in Alma (date and time TBD). Darlyne's wishes were to have her remains utilized for teaching purposes at Wayne State School of Medicine.
