With a heavy heart, we wish to share that Amy Marie Jensen, 46, passed away comfortably on Thursday, April 2, 2026, after a long battle with cancer. She was born in Warren, Michigan on April 24, 1979 to Karen Marie Perun and Richard Paul Fischer (deceased). She is survived by her husband, Nicholas Jensen of 25 years, her stepson Collin Mann (Katerina), her three fur babies (Mia, Pedro and Rolo), her two brothers, Richard Fischer Jr. (Julie) and Eric Fischer (Deanna), as well as numerous family and close friends.

Amy received a bachelor of arts degree from the University of Michigan Dearborn in December 2006. She was employed as a probation officer in the city of Detroit and served with distinction with the Michigan Liquor Control Commission for 28 years.

Amy was an avid runner competing in hundreds of 5K races, several half marathons and completed her dream of a full marathon by running the Detroit Free Press event in 2012.

Upon her cancer diagnosis, Amy dedicated her life to spreading awareness and advocacy and supporting others along their cancer journey. She traveled to Washington DC to encourage further funding be directed to colorectal cancer research and appeared on local television and in a documentary presentation to promote awareness.
