



Anthony P. Noga

August 29, 1939 - March 17, 2024

Anthony (Tony) Peter Noga, of Macomb, Michigan, has gone to his heavenly home on March 17, 2024. He was 84.

Tony was born to the late Michael and Helen Noga in Cleveland, Ohio. He grew up in Ohio where he graduated from Parma Senior High School, and then attended Case Western Reserve University for a year. In 1958, Tony enlisted in the U.S. Marines Corps and served 4 years and then transferred to the Marine Corps Reserve for an additional 2 years. In 1959, Tony and Lori were married, and lived on the base in Camp Lejeune, North Carolina.

A career in sales brought Tony and his family to Michigan, living in the Sterling Heights area for the majority of his adult life. As a proud veteran, in his later years, he loved to volunteer at various high schools and interviewed WWII veterans with their families which captured their experiences in the war. A student videographer filmed the interviews, and the families were each given a video tape as a keepsake.

Tony was preceded in death by his beloved parents Michael and Helen Noga, and his sister Michaelene (Mickey) Mondry. He is survived by his wife of 64 years, Loretta (Lori); sons Damon (Debbie) Noga and Scott (Patty) Noga; daughter Celeste (Jeff) Ludwig; grandchildren Michael, Danielle and Lauren Noga; Nicolas and Evan Noga; Ashley (Billy) Baumann and Amanda (Tim) Gonyeau; and great grandchildren Isabella, Luca, Dylan, and Milo.

His loved ones will remember his love and pride for our country; the silly jokes he often shared with his grandchildren; the touch football games he often

played even when he was in his 70's; showing up at his grandchildren's events to cheer them on; and the love and devotion he had for his wife, Lori. A memorial mass honoring Tony's life will be held on April 26, 2024 at St. Lawrence Church, 44633 Utica Rd, in Utica, with instate at 9:30am until the time of mass at 10am.
