



Bernard S. Pavlosky

December 31, 1928 - December 4, 2015

Pavlosky, Bernard S., age 86, a longtime resident of Detroit, passed away on December 4, 2015 at his home. He was born on December 31, 1928 in Connellsville, Pennsylvania, the youngest of 12 children, to the late Andrew and Frances Pavlosky. Bernard was the husband of Rita Landry for 63 years, married on October 11, 1952 in Dearborn.

Bernard was a WWII U.S. Army veteran, formerly stationed in Alaska, and a victory medal recipient. He earned his accounting degree and MBA from West Virginia University and later served as an officer for the Michigan Association of CPAs. He was a Gesu Catholic Church parishioner and active in their soup kitchen. He also spent time serving the homeless through St. Vincent de Paul. Bernard served as both an officer and driver for the University District Radio Patrol and was a member of the K of C Father Saylor #3774 of Allen Park.

Bernard loved to travel and his motto was, "Take the scenic route". He traveled to Mexico, Italy, Paris, London, Switzerland, Hawaii, and even trekked to Alaska by car. His love for Civil War history inspired him to visit nearly every battlefield in the country, some on multiple occasions. He was a diehard Lions fan and avid golfer. His grandchildren will fondly remember him taking them to the Detroit Thanksgiving parade every year and being quizzed on the capitals of every state (in alphabetical order).
