Carl E. Lindquist, age 94, passed away peacefully in the arms of his loving wife and children on Tuesday, February 4, 2025, in Sterling Heights, Michigan. Born on January 13, 1931, in Detroit, Michigan, Carl was the beloved son of the late Carl H. and Ivah A. (née Benjamin) Lindquist.
