



## Carol Nenciarini

March 18, 1957 - December 17, 2025

Carol Nenciarini passed away in Livonia, Michigan, after a life defined by dedication, creativity, and deep love for her family and community. She grew up in Madison Heights and spent her adult life in Royal Oak, where she built a career, a home, and lasting relationships.

Carol was the beloved wife of Robert Nenciarini. The two were married on February 17, 2018, at Bell Creek Community Church, beginning a marriage rooted in faith, love, and companionship.

She was a loving stepmother to Julianne; Angela (Michael) Payne; and Timothy (Ashley) Nenciarini, and she cherished her role within their lives. Her commitment, adaptability, and strong work ethic were evident throughout her career. She retired in October of 2018, leaving behind a legacy of service and respect among her colleagues.

Outside of work, Carol found joy in gardening and interior design, expressing her creativity through beautiful and welcoming spaces. In her younger years, she raised rabbits, a reflection of her nurturing nature. One of her greatest pleasures was spending time at the family cottage in Gladwin, where she made many treasured memories.
