



Chester E. Limbaugh

March 9, 1933 - February 10, 2022

Chester Eugene Limbaugh, age 88, passed away on February 10, 2022. He was born on March 9, 1933 in Tullahoma, TN to Thomas Limbaugh and Kathleen Richardson Limbaugh. At the age of four, his family moved to Chicago. He attended St. Luke Lutheran School where he was baptized as a first grader and later confirmed on Palm Sunday, 1948. Following graduation from Lane Tech High School in Chicago, Chester served two years in the U.S. Army.

Chester and Beverly (nee Gardner) were married at St. Luke on June 4, 1955 and immediately relocated to Los Angeles, CA where Chester earned a Bachelor of Professional Arts from the Art Center College of Design. The Limbaugh's moved to Royal Oak in 1958 and Chester took a position at Chrysler Corporation where he worked as an Exterior Designer for 38 years.

Chester and Beverly were blessed with two sons, Chester Jr. (1958-2007) (Helen) and Thomas (Sandra). In 64 years as a member of St. Paul, Chester served as an elder, Board of Education Chairman and Bethel teacher. He also designed the ship emblem on the pulpit of St. Paul. He enjoyed painting with water colors and acrylics and was an avid golfer.

Chester is survived by his wife of 66 years, Beverly; son, Thomas (Sandra); daughter-in-law, Helen; grandchildren, Zachary Limbaugh; Jeremy Fuchs

(Erika); Justin Fuchs (Autumn); Charlyn Fuchs; great-grandchildren, Landon Limbaugh; Mason Fuchs; Nova Fuchs-Smith and Elle Fuchs; and sister Mary Bollinger (Jim).

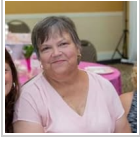
