Clara Wing, formerly of Royal Oak, Michigan passed away peacefully on May 5, 2017 in Royal Oak.

She had lived in the Oxford Park Towers in Berkley, MI for the last 18 years. Clara was born in Detroit on September 14, 1920. She graduated from Lincoln High School in Ferndale in 1938.

Clara was the wife of WW2 veteran James R. Wing and a mother of 6 children. She served as a Sunday school teacher, Girl Scout leader, family chauffeur, bookkeeper, watercolor artist AND homemaker. As a cook, she served dinner every night at 6:05 pm.

Clara remained active and belonged to the Unity Church, the RED HATS, the Daughters of the American Revolution and the PEO. She was always ready – for visiting, traveling and dining out. Her hair always remained perfect and was done by the same hairdresser for the last 30 years.

As a SENIOR, she enjoyed her many years living at Oxford Park Towers. She enjoyed the card games, the daily “Meals on Wheels”, the weekly trip to MEIJER and the Saturday get-togethers and the Thursday visits of Pastor Ray from Our Shepherd Lutheran Church in Birmingham.

She loved baseball and told her children stories about Babe Ruth and Al Kaline. If it was baseball season, she would not miss a Tigers Game- hopefully on television but... at least on the radio. The TIGERS were her favorites!

Clara leaves 6 children, Janet, Jim, Ken, Bob, Paul and Mary. She also leaves 19 grandchildren and great grandchildren – each one was her “favorite.”
