Clarence Stiff, 89, a lifelong Royal Oak resident, died Friday, Nov. 25, 2005, in Troy. He was born Oct. 1, 1916, in Royal Oak. Mr. Stiff was a first sergeant in the U.S. Army during World War II. He was acting chief of the Royal Oak Fire Department when he retired after 34 years of employment with the department. He was an avid golfer.
