



Clinton Arthur Fogle

December 11, 1938 - August 30, 2023

Clinton Arthur Fogle Sr., age 84, of Royal Oak, departed this world on August 30, 2023, leaving behind a legacy of love, adventure, and service.

Born in Detroit, Clinton's roots ran deep in the Royal Oak community where he was raised. He graduated from St. Mary High School and went on to earn bachelor's and master's degrees from Eastern Michigan University and Michigan State University. Following four years of service in the United States Air Force, during which time he had two of his children, he returned home to build his career and continue adding to his family. Throughout his life, Clinton would go on to own and operate several businesses, including a bakery, a bed and bath store, and his cherished "The Monogram Store" on Woodward Avenue. Yet, perhaps his most remarkable achievement was raising four children as a devoted single father during this time.

In his sixties, while many his age were contemplating a relaxing retirement, Clinton embarked on a new chapter by joining the Peace Corps and dedicating himself to service abroad. He completed two tours, first in St. Lucia and later in Morocco, leaving a lasting impact on the communities he served.

Upon leaving the Peace Corps, Clinton's sense of adventure did not fade. Between attending his grandchildren's sporting events—his strikingly prominent white hair impossible to miss as he cheered from the stands—he

continued his global exploration during retirement. His travels spanned the Middle East, Africa, the Pacific, and countless points in-between. His adventures even took him to the remote island of Yap, where he spent several enriching months. Not slowing down much even into his eighties, Clinton completed an unforgettable Alaska cruise just shortly before his passing.

Through his zest for life, his commitment to service, and profound love for his family, Clinton will forever be missed but fondly remembered. His legacy is a testament to a life lived to the fullest.

Clinton is survived by his children, Clinton Fogle Jr., Clare (Maurice Houeix) Fogle, John (Glee) Fogle, and James (Corrie) Fogle, as well as his grandchildren: Grant Fogle, Phillip Fogle, Febe Fogle, and Chloe Fogle. He is further survived by his sister, Anne Fogle, his brother-in-law, Shane Murphy, and many nieces, nephews, great-nieces, and great-nephews. He was predeceased by his parents, Howard and Hilarita Fogle; and his siblings, Howard Fogle and Mary Ellen Murphy.

Visitation will take place on Monday, September 4 from 4 – 8 p.m. (Rosary at 7 p.m.), at Wm. Sullivan & Son Funeral Home, 705 W. Eleven Mile Rd. (four blocks east of Woodward), Royal Oak. Funeral Mass will be celebrated on Tuesday, September 5 at 10 a.m. (visitation 9:30 a.m.) at National Shrine of the Little Flower, 2100 Twelve Mile Rd., Royal Oak.
