Cynthia Louise Larson (nee Zagar) (45) passed away on April 27, 2022, at Beaumont Hospital in Royal Oak, Michigan, after a 9-month battle with colorectal cancer metastasized to lymph nodes, bone, and liver. Cindy was born in Royal Oak, Michigan, and resided in Madison Heights, Sterling Heights, Warren, and Waterford Twp. She graduated from Sterling Heights High School, attended Schoolcraft College in Livonia, and later went on to become an RN after earning her Associates degree in Nursing from Macomb Community College. 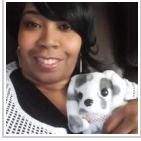
