David K. Card, age 73, of Royal Oak, was a proud Marine, Vietnam veteran, wonderful husband, great dad and friend to many. Born in Alton, Illinois in 1943 to parents, Walter and Lolittia Card, David passed away at Beaumont Hospital in Royal Oak on February 21, 2017. He is survived by his loving wife, Carol (Hanchett); sister, Linda (James) Treesh of Wasilla, Alaska; and brother, Norman (Donna) Card of Crawfordville, Florida. His two sons also survive him, David Jr. of Athens, Georgia and Thomas (Stephanie Gold) of Chappaqua, New York. He was very proud of his three beautiful granddaughters, Riley, Sophie and Bailey, all of Chappaqua, New York.

David graduated in 1961 from Carmi Township High School in Carmi, Illinois. He became a U.S. Marine shortly thereafter and obtained the rank of Cpl (E-4). He was a lineman for Southern Bell Telephone for several years before entering college at Southern Illinois University, where he earned his Bachelors of Science in accounting and later received his CPA. David worked in accounting for the remainder of his career, locally for ND Industries, Troy and New Horizons Rehabilitation Services, Auburn Hills.

David enjoyed flying, playing golf with friends, and traveling, especially to Hawaii, Alaska, New England, and with family. Many hours of relaxation time were spent up north on the AuSable River and dining out with "the girlfriends".
