David Paul Hill, age 64, of Hillman, formerly of Ferndale, died February 2, 2009 at his home. He was born April 2, 1944 in Williamsburg, KY. Mr. Hill made his home in Ferndale from 1979-1996. He has lived in Hillman since 1996. Mr. Hill came to Michigan in 1949. He retired from GM Livonia Plant in 1995 after 30 years. He was a U.S. Army veteran who served 18 months in Germany during the Vietnam War. He is survived by his wife, Janice E. DeWolf Hill, whom he married on March 16, 1994, in Gatlinburg, TN, but they had been together for 54 years; children, Lori Roy Salazar of Milford, Heidi Joe Crisi of Inkster, David P.
