



## David James Hoehn

May 26, 1981 - December 7, 2023

David "Dave" James Hoehn, 42, of Jacksonville, North Carolina, passed away on December 7, 2023 in Jacksonville.

David was born in Mount Clemens, Michigan to James W. and Barbara G (nee Caldwell) Hoehn on May 26, 1981. He went to West Ottawa High School in Holland, Michigan, and graduated in 1999. In 2000, David enlisted in the United States Marine Corps and proudly served 3 ½ years before being honorably discharged. While in the service, he received numerous medals, decorations, and ribbons: Combat Action Ribbon (Iraq); Global War on Terrorism Service Medal; Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal (Kuwait); Sea Service Deployment Ribbon; National Defense Service Medal; Presidential Unit Citation (Navy); and the Rifle Qualification Badge (marksman).

David was a sport enthusiast. He loved the sport of baseball and played from the age of 5 through his senior year of high school where he was the starting pitcher for West Ottawa. He had a deep love for the Detroit sports teams, especially the Tigers and Lions. He was also a fan of the U of M Wolverines. David was a devoted and loving father to his 5 surviving children: Jordan (17), twins Summer and Illianamarie (17), Gregory (13), and Christian (10). He is also survived by his parents James and Barbara, formerly of Utica; brothers Brian (Erin) Hoehn and Jarrod (Kelly) Hoehn; and nieces and nephews Valerie, Maddison, Landon, and Oliver.

David was preceded in death by his grandparents William G. Hoehn, Ardith M.

(nee Scribner) Hoehn, Thomas B. Caldwell, and Betty L. (nee Storck)  
Caldwell.
