Sr. Mary of the Incarnate Word, O.P., died peacefully August 16, 2016 at home, with her sisters at the Monastery of the Blessed Sacrament. She was 81 and in the 60th year of her profession as a Cloistered Dominican Nun.

Sr. Mary of the Incarnate Word (Dolores Bricher), was born July 3, 1935 in Saint Paul, Minnesota. She came to the Monastery of the Blessed Sacrament in Farmington Hills from Minnesota. Besides her ministry of prayer, Sister served her community faithfully as infirmarian, gardener and singer during daily liturgies and the Divine Office. She was the beloved daughter of the late Lester and Frances (Pawlicki) Bricher; and loving sister of Janet Bruker, Charles Wayne, Joseph Martin, John Clark and the late Sr. Mary Rosalie.

David Santoro, O.P., Monastery Chaplain, will preside at the Funeral Mass. Burial at Holy Sepulchre Cemetery, Southfield.
