Edward T. O'Neill, age 92, a resident of Royal Oak since 1950, died September 9, 2011 at his home. He was born November 30, 1918 in Laurium, MI to the late Edward and Ellen O'Neill. Mr. O'Neill served in the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II. He retired from the Chrysler Corporation in 1980 after 24 years of service.
