What a day, glorious day that will be!*

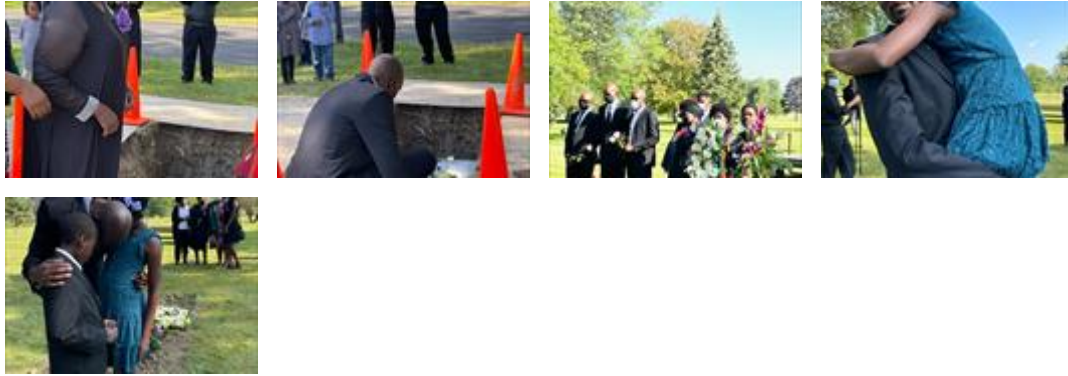
