Sonny (Elmer) Ferdinand Rinke, age 71, passed away on November 22, 2021. Sonny lived a life helping those around him, making and sharing all the best stories, dreaming of ways to make everything work better, and loving his family. He was born on December 2, 1949 to Speed (Elmer) and Lorraine Rinke. Sonny was raised in Utica, MI with a love for fishing, cars, and fixing anything broken. He served proudly in the 11th Armored Cavalry Regiment (ACR) in the Vietnam war.

The majority of his professional career was with the Experi-Metal sheet metal company in Sterling Heights, MI, helping connect customers with manufacturing solutions.
