“ To the family of Elsa, please allow me to express my deep sadness at the loss of your beloved relative. Miss Holderried was at Winterhalter Elementary School when I attended. From 1955 when I attended kindergarten until I left when my family joined the migration from Detroit she was a driving force to be reckoned with at Winterhalter... I actually have her autograph in an old autograph book from low those years ago. She alternated between being the principal and assistant principle, as I recall, Mrs. Cross became ill and Miss Holderried took over running the place... she was a magnificent woman with charm and grace and my funny memory was that I never understood as a child, how she could be the principal at a predominantly Jewish attended elementary school (we always closed down during the Jewish holidays because attendance was so low) when she was 'so Catholic'. She was gracious in explaining how God watched over us all and it didn't matter as long as we believed. I hope this give you a small chuckle as I am sure God still watches over us all, regardless. My thoughts of her are wonderful, she was a woman's woman before we all got 'liberated'. To each of you out there, due to family matters I will be unable to attend her services, however, my mind and soul will be with you all... 99 years is a long time to serve. She did so with grace and humility. My sincerest thoughts for your loss. We have all lost a great woman who made the world a better place.
