Erlinda Doctora

Age 86, Passed away on March 9, 2024.

Born April 6, 1937, in Isabela, Negros Occidental, the Philippines to the late Jesus and Rodriga Dolendo. Beloved wife of Romeo, with whom she spent over 58 loving years. In addition to Romeo, she is survived by her adoring children, Dr. Joseph Doctora of Nashville, TN; Lynn (Russ) Suiter of Shelby Twp., MI; Jocelyn Jurva of Brookfield, WI; Carolyn (Luis) Lomas of Williamston, MI; and nephew Andrew Dolendo of Toronto, Ontario, Canada and Dr. Jason Jurva of Steamboat Springs, CO, both of whom she loved as

her own children. She was the proud grandmother of J. Wesley, August, and Axel Jurva; Mikayla Lomas; Ella and Kai Doctora; and Elly, Jacob, and Julian Dolendo.

Linda moved from the Philippines to New Jersey in 1962 after graduating from San Augustin University in Iloilo, Philippines with a Bachelor of Science degree in Pharmacy. She came as a part of a Medical Technology student program. Upon completion, she moved to various cities in the Midwest, including Chicago, Detroit, and Terre Haute, IN, as well as Toronto, Canada to work. She and Romeo ultimately settled in Shelby Twp., MI, where they raised their children. Linda worked at St. Joseph's Hospital in Clinton Township for many years and worked at St. John's hospital where she retired at 78 years old after she suffered her first stroke.

Linda was a hard worker and tenaciously and stubbornly persevered through life's challenges. Her motto in life was "If other people can do it, so can I". She always strived to do better and be better. She was loving, thoughtful, and generous to a fault, always putting others' needs before her own. She gave generously to her family living in the Philippines and helped relatives when they arrived in the United States from the Philippines.

She was a devout Catholic and longtime parishioner of St. Lawrence Church. She sent all her kids to Catholic school and instilled in them the importance of prayer, faith, and education. She was known to say the rosary as she drove to work and home.

Linda's family was her greatest joy, and she cherished traveling with her husband around the country to spend time with them. She especially enjoyed spending time with her children and grandchildren at a family home on Anna Maria Island, Florida; memorable trips to Nice, France and Maui, Hawaii with her beloved Romeo; and frequent trips "home" to the Philippines.
