Evelyn S. "Evie" Bell, age 93, passed away on October 21, 2021. She was born on September 21, 1928 in Heidelberg, Germany to Karl Siebenhaar and Ella Leim Siebenhaar. The family immigrated to the US when Evie was an infant, first living in New York and then moving to Michigan. She met Glenn Bell while attending Royal Oak High School, where she graduated in 1947. In 1952, the couple married, first living on campus at MSU and later making their home in Royal Oak where they raised their daughter. Evie loved music and was involved singing in the chorale group during high school and as an adult in a local chorale group. She was a longtime member of First Presbyterian Church. She was an avid crafter and enjoyed weaving baskets, working with stained glass, loved to sew and knit. Some of her other hobbies include playing cards and dominos, skiing, camping and gardening. In the 1940's and 1950's her father and friends formed the Kandahar Ski Club, a private ski club that started in Pontiac and moved to Fenton. Evie was Social Director, Secretary, and was on the Ski Patrol while she belonged to the club from the 1950's-1980's. She enjoyed watching sports and was an avid MSU football fan. In her younger years, she and Glenn were season ticket holders for the Detroit Pistons. Evie was a longtime lover of animals, especially cats, and had many feline friends throughout the years.
