Evelyn Alice Stieg (nee Brauer), age 96, resident of Utica, passed away on Thursday, August 19, 2021 in Shelby Township, Michigan.

Evelyn was born on April 19, 1925 in Ann Arbor, Michigan to the late Rev. Carl A. and Alice (nee Eifert) Brauer. Her father was a pastor for over 50 years at St. Paul Lutheran Church, Ann Arbor, where she became active in her younger years. She married the love of her life Dr. Raymond E. Stieg D.D.S on August 26, 1950, they were married for over 50 years before Raymond's passing on September 18, 2002.

Evelyn and Raymond made their home in Utica, Michigan where her husband would establish his dental practice. Evelyn attended college at Eastern Michigan University, Valparaiso University and graduated from University of Michigan. A member of Trinity Lutheran Church-Utica since 1954 where she was active in the Ladies Aid, Lutheran Women's Missionary League, Golden Circle, the choir, hand bells, Bible classes, and many other activities. Evelyn was an active family historian, and documented the Brauer family history dating back several generations.
