Frank B. Pardo, a beloved father, grandfather, and esteemed member of the community, passed away on July 8, 2023. He leaves behind a legacy of hard work, dedication, and a passion for life that touched the hearts of all who knew him.

Born on June 15, 1933, Frank was an exceptional individual from the start. He demonstrated his determination and intelligence by graduating from Southeastern High School in 1950, a year ahead of his peers at the young age of 17. Immediately following his graduation, he embarked on an academic journey at the University of Detroit, where he became a full-time student in September 1950.

However, Frank's education was briefly put on hold when he was inducted into the U.S. Army on December 1, 1955. He served his country with honor and distinction in Korea, and due to his dedication to his studies, he was granted an early discharge in August 1957, allowing him to return to the University of Detroit to complete his degree. With perseverance and resilience, Frank graduated from the university in June 1958, earning a degree that would lay the foundation for a successful career ahead.

Frank's professional journey began at the young age of 7 when he started

working. Over the years, he held various jobs in the automotive industry, which eventually led to starting his own very successful consulting firm known as "Resource Management." Later, in 1995, Frank embarked on a career in Cadillac car sales. His exceptional sales skills and dedication to his customers propelled him to great heights. In his first year, he ranked among the top 100 salespeople, followed by being recognized as one of the top 50 in his second year. He continued to excel, earning a spot among the top 25 in his third year. His remarkable accomplishments culminated in his fourth year, where he achieved the impressive ranking of 4th in the country, a testament to his unwavering commitment to excellence.

Outside of his professional pursuits, Frank had a zest for life. He developed a love for boating, spending countless hours enjoying the open waters. He could often be seen sporting his impressive collection of baseball hats, supporting any team that caught his interest. Not only did he love to bowl, but he was also exceptional at it, achieving a perfect score of 300 in January 2003, at the age of 69. Frank had a giving nature and dedicated himself to caring for many members of his family. He was known as a problem solver, always ready to lend a helping hand or offer sage advice.

Frank B. Pardo will be deeply missed by his family, friends, and all those whose lives he touched. His kindness, determination, and love for life will forever remain in the hearts of those who had the privilege of knowing him. May he rest in eternal peace, his memory cherished and celebrated by all who knew and loved him.
