George T. Goike, a beloved resident of Bruce Township, passed away peacefully on August 6, 2024, in Clinton Township, Michigan, just two days shy of his 94th birthday. Born on August 8, 1930, in Warren Township, Michigan, George was the cherished son of the late Stephen and Irene (née Dobbelstine) Goike.

George was a man of many passions and talents. He found immense joy in gardening and nurturing flowers, and he was an avid bowler. A dedicated sports fan, he faithfully supported the Detroit Lions, Tigers, and Red Wings, and he loved watching boxing matches.

A proud U.S. Army veteran, George served his country honorably during the Korean War. He retired in June 1992.

His love for sports extended to coaching, where he made a positive impact as a Little League Baseball Coach and a Girls Softball Coach for White

Chapel Cemetery.

George is also survived by his sister, Maggie Goike, and a host of nieces and nephews.
