With heavy hearts, we announce the death of Geraldine McCormick of Troy, formerly a longtime resident of Royal Oak. Geraldine was born in Detroit, Michigan to the late Pauline and Vincent Erpelding. Geraldine is survived by her children: Patrick (Allison) McCormick, Vincent (Bruce) McCormick, James (Carolyn) McCormick, Julia Rogers, and Robert (Loretta) McCormick. In addition to being a loving mother of eight children, Geraldine was a successful career woman. After completing nursing training at Providence Hospital, she worked as a pediatric registered nurse and then an intensive care nurse for decades. After completing her Bachelor of Science in nursing and Master's degree in Health Care Management, Geraldine moved into nursing management at Providence Hospital in Southfield. In addition to her

full-time responsibilities as a nursing supervisor, Geraldine began teaching clinical nursing for Henry Ford Community College. In addition to many recognitions of her accomplishments at Providence Hospital, Geraldine received the coveted “Nightingale Award People's Choice Award” for nursing excellence from Oakland University. She continued to work in the nursing field she loved until she was 87 years old. To this day, you can still meet nurses she has trained and worked with who speak very highly of her dedication to the field of nursing and her exceptional clinical skills.
