Gerard R. Foley, age 80, and resident of Macomb Township, passed away on November 2, 2017 at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit. Gerard was born in Detroit, where he attended grade school and high school at Holy Redeemer, later graduating with his bachelor's degree from Indiana University. He also completed a long career with General Motors, spending 40 years with the company as an engineer. Notably proud of his Irish heritage, Gerard served as Grand Marshall of the annual Detroit St. Patrick's Parade for nineteen years.

Gerard was an avid athlete and loved sports of all kinds-in particular, he had a passion for swimming and was a longtime member of the Macomb Township Recreation Center. He also had a great sense of humor. Whenever someone asked how he was doing, Gerard would reply, "Top Shelf!"

Gerard also had a strong faith in God and was a longtime member of St. Peter Catholic Church. He was greatly loved by his family and will be dearly missed.
