“Glorchen”, as we (the German part of the family) called her, will always be remembered as an extraordinarily loving and warm-hearted person.

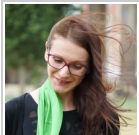
We are very grateful that we were able to spend another 3 weeks with her and the whole family this July! We have to remember that what we have once enjoyed we can never lose.
