



## Hayla F. Joneson

Hayla Florence Joneson passed away at the age of 82 on November 5, 2024, surrounded by the love of her family. Born on March 1, 1942, in Detroit, Michigan, Hayla lived a full life filled with love, generosity, and joy.

grow up in. Though Hayla was heartbroken by Fred's passing in 1997, her grandchildren and her love of teaching allowed her to continue to embrace life with her signature positivity and resilience. Her family finds solace in knowing they are reunited again.

Hayla's travels brought her joy and wonder - exploring Sweden, Belgium, Greece, Italy, Brazil, and countless other beautiful places. A lover of the outdoors, she truly enjoyed being by the beach, especially in Venice, Florida where she spent many winters during retirement with Phil. Her heart, however, was most at home during summers in Irons, Michigan, where she welcomed family and friends to enjoy nights around the firepit, grilling, and endless summer days by the creek. These gatherings created a tapestry of memories that her family will cherish forever.

Hayla's creativity was as boundless as her compassion; she poured love into the quilts she sewed, and the many items she knitted, each one a testament to her patience and artistry. Known for her gentle spirit, she was the embodiment of kindness, a grounding presence for everyone who knew her, and a friend to many. Her warmth, humor, and enduring positivity left a permanent mark on all whose lives she touched.

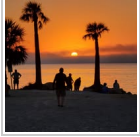
