



Hazel Morene Callahan

February 22, 1921 - January 19, 2012

Hazel Morene McIntosh Callahan, age 90, a resident of Royal Oak, died January 19, 2012 at Beaumont Health System in Royal Oak. She was born February 22, 1921 in Athol, KY to the late Sherman and Chelsea Coomer McIntosh. Mrs. Callahan was a 1938 graduate of Highland Institute in Guerrant, KY and 1940 graduate of Montreat College in Montreat, NC. She was a teacher in a one-room school in Jetts Creek, KY. She moved to Michigan and worked for Dodge Truck on the Jeep assembly line during World War II. She was a substitute teacher in Madison and Hazel Park school districts.
