



## Henry W. " Hank" Scheper

Henry W. Scheper, a resident of Novi, Mi passed away on November 27, 2017 at the Henry Ford West Bloomfield Hospital, West Bloomfield , MI. Former resident of the Sterling Heights and Utica area. He was born on January 17th, 1928; in Utica, Michigan to his late parents Henry F. and Else L. Scheper. Henry attended Trinity Lutheran School and graduated from Utica High School as Valedictorian of the Class of 1945 and was a member of the "Dead Canaries Club". He graduated with Honors from the University of Cincinnati with a degree in BSEE and later was P.E. Certified. Served in the United States Army from 1950-52. Henry worked the family business where he later became President and Owner of Scheper Electric until his retirement in Utica, Michigan.
