



## Jack L. Nelson

August 4, 1920 - December 29, 2017

Jack Nelson, age 97, of Shelby Township, passed away on December 29, 2017. Jack was born in Franklin, Pennsylvania and served with the U.S. Marine Corps in the Pacific Theatre during World War II. He later worked as a journeyman grinder in the Tool and Die business for N.A. Woodworth for 30 years, retiring in September 1984. He was also the president of the local 6 chapter of the Mechanics Educational Society of America. In his spare time, Jack was an avid golfer, square dancer, and Euchre player.

Jack is survived by his wife, Marion (née Brock); his children: James (Janet) Nelson, Martha Nelson, Jack (Kathleen) Nelson, Lawrence (Cindy) Nelson, and Dawn (Christopher) Brown; nine grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; and his sister, Nancy. 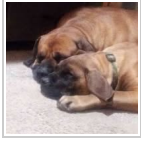

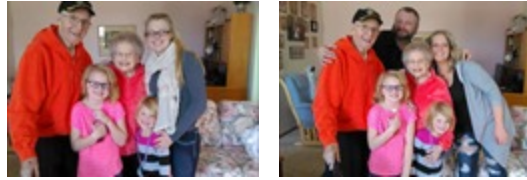
