We fished and swam and enjoyed ourselves over the weekend. Some members, Diane, Ellen and Bobby Jones, Mary R. had to return home Sunday afternoon for various reasons. This left Grandpa Robinson, Michael Jones, Karen, Renold and Jason Jerome still at the cabin on Sunday night. Later that evening, daughter Karen called down the hill from the Cabin to me Andy sitting on the Big Bench to "Come Quick, Dad." I hurried up the hill and found Jason in a convulsion in Karen and Renold's arms, turning blue and not breathing. Thank Michigan Bell, I had just finished a Refresher First Aid Course. I tried to clear his airway and found his tongue curled up blocking his airpipe. Hurriedly, I tried to clear his tongue out of his throat and started to give mouth to mouth resuscitation. Meanwhile, Michael was sent to get help, if possible. Michael found our neighbor, Sherrie Ramsey, a registered nurse who came over to help us. Renold, Karen and Sherrie took Jason to the hospital in Reed City, MI. They didn't find out exactly what caused the problem but suggested a complete physical by his Pediatrician. St. John Hospital found out that he had a hole in his diaphragm the very next day after a rushed trip home. Naturally, an operation was performed to close the hole immediately. Jason then thrived and was a wonderful little Grandson. We are blessed that God let him be with us for approximately 25 more years.
