She was a hard worker, working all of her adult life, first at Chrysler, where she received a citation from the U.S. War Dept. for work essential to the production of the atomic bomb, which helped end World War II. She also worked for the Kinney Shoe Corp., where she could sell the hell out of purses and nylons while running the register. She also did the store books at home. She retired after 25 yrs.

She was so proud of her Polish heritage and living in Hamtramck. She loved living in her little home on Commor street and taking care of it. She loved belonging to St. Ladislaus Parish and volunteering there while in retirement.

She also was one heck of a bowler.

She always made sure we had what we needed and managed everything at home, as my dad was not the greatest father. She put both my brother and I through 12 yrs. of Catholic school (St. Lads) and encouraged us in our studies and sports.

Once her Knees gave out, she moved to Wellbridge of Rochester Hills where she lived for the last four years. She could be temperamental at times but also had the sweetest side to her. I want to thank the staff at Wellbridge of Rochester Hills for taking such good care of her and keeping her comfortable and safe. When you asked her, her secret to such a long life (97) she would smile and say one daily glass of Manischewitz blackberry (1 only)
