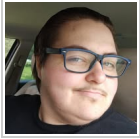

I love you E-pa. Thanks for being my world.

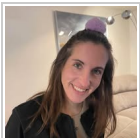

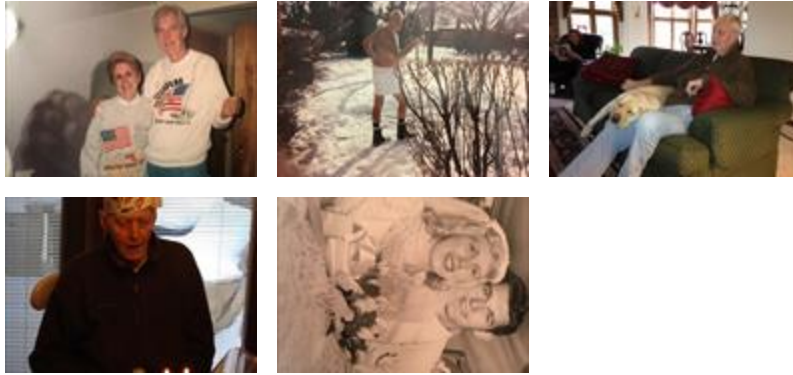
