John Clemence Krause, a resident of Warren, passed away on August 23, 2023 at the age of 89. A son of Clemens and Martha Krause, he was born on December 27, 1933. John proudly served in the U.S. Army for two years before establishing a career with Ameritech. He retired in 1990 after 35 years with the company. John exchanged vows with Barbara A.
