

“ I remember John wanting to come skiing with Tom and I, and we said "no" because we were in high school and he was [well] a couple years younger than us, and we were trying to act older. John ended up joining the ski team in high school and becoming a better skier than both Tom and I. John sold me a pair of his Kastle RS Racing skis that he used in high school. Those skies became my all-time favorite. Let me give you a perspective on that. I lived for a season at Steamboat Springs Colorado, and because of my job I was able to demo any ski I wanted. So, I demoed every ski available. And, I went on to buy every ski I wanted. I even bought 2 more Kastle RS's, but they were never the same as that pair that I bought off of John. That pair was so lively, they would jump out of any turn, and if you weren't over them, they would fly out from under you. I currently own somewhere between 30-40 pairs of ski. And, nothing compares to those skis that I bought off of John. Lastly, I remember John becoming the manager of a local restaurant at a very young age...John was in high school is what I remember. Tom and I were so impressed. He was in charge over everyone at the restaurant, and many people under him were much older than he was. John could talk. At a young age. John was a very good conversationalist, and I'm sure he nailed that interview for that manager's position. Any time you talked to John, he would always use your name as he was responding back to you. This gave you the impression that John was always talking directly to you, and made the conversation more personal.

Those are my memories of John. He died way too young.
