John Charles Mueller, age 81, passed away on August 9, 2024, leaving a legacy of wisdom, humor, and love. He was born in Elmhurst, IL on January 3, 1943, to John Edward Mueller and Elizabeth Murphy Mueller. His journey through life was marked by a love of learning and good conversation, appreciation of nuance, a connection to the physical world around him that was expressed in his design and craftsmanship, and steadfast devotion to family.

When John was eleven, he and his family moved to Royal Oak, MI. He would remain in Michigan the rest of his life, where he built a life with his family. A graduate of the University of Detroit High School, he followed the influence of the Jesuits to the University of Detroit, where he found his calling in architecture and teaching.

John's professional life reflected his talent for design and his love of teaching. While he practiced with distinction his whole career, he devoted 37 years to passing on his knowledge to others as a beloved professor and mentor. As a student of his at the University of Detroit Mercy wrote, "He'll teach you things you won't understand the importance of for years. His dedication to design and craft are second to none."

Throughout his life John found other ways to express his talent and pursue his

interests. His hands were as skilled in woodwork and carpentry as they were in architectural design and drafting, beautifying the places where he and his loved ones lived. He loved to read, an inspiration for many great discussions. He became an accomplished cook, spoiling his friends and family with his culinary skills. For him a meal was best enjoyed with a bottle of good wine and conversation.

John loved spending time with his family, and looked forward to the many summer trips they made together to the family cottage in Manistee. He was the beloved husband of the late Antonina "Toni" Mueller, whom he cherished and stood by. He was also the adored father of Alexandra "Alex" Mueller, who couldn't have asked for a more wonderful dad.

John was also the dearly loved brother of Michael (Patty, and the late Pamela) Mueller, Betsy (Jerry) Pease, Paul (Laurie) Mueller, Carl Mueller, and Marty (Marty) Bouveron, and was uncle to many dear nieces and nephews.
