John Wylie White, a Troy resident, went to be with our Lord and Savior on Tuesday evening, November 29, 2022 at the age of 83. The beloved son of John and Margery (nee Johnson), he was born on the coldest day of the year, February 23, 1939 in Canton, Ohio. John earned a bachelor's degree from Oberlin Music Conservatory before earning his master's degree from the University of Cincinnati. He spent a year abroad studying music in the Mozarteum University Salzburg Austria and had the opportunity to play under the direction of Herbert von Karajan. He wed the love of his life, Barbara Lex, on June 11, 1966 at the National Shrine of the Little Flower Basilica in Royal Oak, Michigan.

John embarked upon his teaching vocation in Navarre, Ohio as a high school vocal music instructor in 1965. The following year, he transitioned to the Bloomfield Hills School District in Michigan as a vocal music instructor and band director for elementary and middle school students. An inspiration to his students, John provided positive encouragement that led to award winning bands. John's desire to teach extended into his home, where he shared his creative talents with his children. John devoted his life to his family. He was passionate about spending time with his family, never missing an opportunity to be in their lives. On summer breaks, John created numerous adventures and memorable family experiences.

John was a kind, gentle, and caring man who was guided by faith and principle. God and family were always foremost in his life. John shared his love for God with his family and others who intersected his life. He prayed fervently for his family, friends, and country. John had an indomitable spirit in the face of adversity and will be dearly missed. Beloved husband of Barbara, joined in love for 56 years. Loving father of Katharina (Timothy) Campbell and John (Marcele) White. Cherished grandfather of Darin and Colby Campbell. Close friend of Carl Gettig, Heinz Bitzenberger, Bob Binkelman, and the late Mike Petschel.

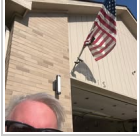
