Joseph A. Syler, Sr.

Age 76, passed away on February 11, 2024. He was born August 18, 1947 in Detroit, Michigan. Beloved son of the late Mary and George Syler.

Joseph was Married to his beloved wife Loretta on April 17, 1982, at St. John Fisher Chapel in Rochester.
