



Jules Carbonneau

June 14, 1936 - January 26, 2024

Joseph "Jules" Carbonneau, 87, a longtime resident of Center Line, Michigan passed away of natural causes on January 26, 2024. Born in Sainte-Marguerite, Québec, Canada, he grew up alongside a family of one sister and six brothers.

In 1953, Jules made the journey to Michigan, where he eventually met and married Lorraine Dumontet in 1958. The couple settled in Center Line, establishing a loving home where they raised four children. He also served as a volunteer fireman for the city of Center Line, where he forged lasting friendships while contributing his time and efforts to the welfare of the community.

In loving memory, he is survived by his cherished wife, Lorraine (Dumontet),

along with his son David (Lori) Carbonneau and daughters Suzanne (Gordon) Collins, Denise Carbonneau, and Nancy (Brad) Keller. He leaves behind a legacy of seven grandchildren and five great-grandchildren who brought immense joy to his life.

Among his close family, he is also survived by his loving brothers Yves, Andre, and Edmond Carbonneau. Additionally, he is remembered by Laurence Normand and numerous nieces and nephews, who shared in the rich tapestry of his life.
