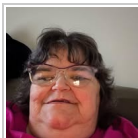

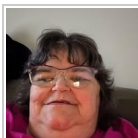

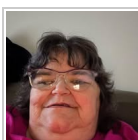

“ Working with Julie as her youth pastor was an experience that encouraged both my wife and I. Julie's heart and compassion for everyone around her was simply amazing. She had a way of encouraging everyone around her to go farther than they thought they could and to find more value than they thought they had. I watched Julie become a mom and fulfill the role of Mom to Tyler with amazing passion and commitment but it didn't stop there. Her grace and wonderful heart only found more purpose with the arrival of Ari.

Years ago when Julie was a student in our group we were on a trip to Indiana and she did something on that trip that encouraged my heart to continue to work with youth. Julie and I had been talking during the drive to an event in Indianapolis. Our conversation was all about life, about God, about faith, and about grace. She seemed to be gaining a better understanding of just who Christ was as we talked. We made a stop just after this talk and the students all went shopping. As we were about to leave students came running out with all manner of junk food and ridiculous rubbish, except Julie. Julie walked out with a gift for my wife and I, a gift that even now is helping my heart cope with this great loss. The gift was a large sandstone cross with the poem *Footprints in the Sand* engraved on it, the cross remains in my home to this day. The significance of that poem was the fact that our conversation before that stop was all about God's Great grace and our need to have great faith in him. I knew at that moment that a simple conversation could help a student's heart to see more clearly that God's love and grace goes beyond our understanding and that it is worth our faithfulness.

If you're not familiar with the *Footprints in the Sand* poem essentially the poem talks about the fact that we often times view God as being void in a time of great need when the truth is Christ, who is God's son, carries us through those great times of need. Right now Christ is carrying all of us during this great time of need. I had no idea just how much that poem and that experience with Julie would be a large part of what is carrying me through this time.

Thank you so much Julie, your compassion is still here with us all. Julie's heart, once again was amazing and full of grace and she is with that same Christ who carries us right now. In his presence is a wonderful place for a heart full of love and grace like Julie's. Let the grace of her heart be an example of the ultimate grace of God! Take a look down at your feet and see a God who loves you and is carrying you even as you read this.
