June loved to dance even up until her death she still had the beat. She was a good cook and loved having people over for dinner. She was always so busy feeding everyone, that she hardly ate herself. She loved experimenting with different dishes and entering cooking contest. Her family never knew what they would have for dinner. She was a wonderful mother and her daughter's best friend. She loved her grandchildren. She has two grandchildren, Brian and Kevin Nancy's children.

Her third husband, Charles had two children they are both deceased and they each had two children and several great grandchildren. Her daughter, Nancy found a poem that her mother had written about the little white church in Leer.
