Karin Gunvor Stoll (née Hansson), age 91, passed away in her sleep on April 19, 2026. She was born on August 8, 1934 in Trönö, Sweden to Hans and Hulda Hansson. Gun was an adventurous soul, travelling with her younger sister to the United States at the age of 19. There she met the love of her life, Dick Stoll, and they eloped in Indiana on June 25, 1955.

Gun was so full of life that she had to share it by raising not just her own children, but all the others around her as well. She had three boys, Mark, Kurt, and Karl, whom she loved dearly. She raised her granddaughter, Karen, and took turns raising up many others. She always had time to show you a small game or teach you a new song. She taught the magical skill of how not to be afraid, and why Easter is always celebrated with witches.

The most immediately noticeable thing about Gun was that she never stopped moving. She could just as easily be found in her basement sewing room or cleaning gutters on the roof of a three-story home. She loved singing and sang for a number of years with a local Swedish women's choir. She cooked for groups large and small, from small family dinners to large community events. Just don't ask her for a recipe for her Swedish pancakes, as she did it all by feeling.

When she wasn't physically moving, she was puzzling: jigsaw puzzles, manipulated puzzles, brain teasers, word games. If there was a mystery to solve, she enjoyed it. Even her TV watching was filled with them: Jeopardy (properly pronounced 'yepardy') for testing knowledge, Murder She Wrote for solving fictional crimes.

Gun was preceded in death by her husband, Dick, her son, Mark, and her siblings, Ingvor, Erik, Arne, and Ann Brit. She is survived by her sons Kurt (Nancy Kung) Stoll and Karl (Esmerelda Whitledge) Stoll. She was cherished grandmother to Karen (Justin) Stoll Farrell, Bryan Stoll, Ian (Jessica) Stoll, and Aaron Stoll, and great-grandmother to Gage Miller, Odin, Penelope, and Amara Farrell, and Aarow, Zoey, Michael, and Seabern Stoll.
