“ Although I went to the burial, I couldn’t bring myself to speak. I’m the emotional type, and when I’m deeply close to someone, I know I’d break down before I could finish a sentence. But I still want to share.

Several hours after his first brain surgery, he briefly woke up. He recognized me and softly said my first and, as most of my closest friends don’t even remember my middle name: “Theresa Lanni.” In that moment, I thought, he’s coming back to us. Then he said, “Grab a pen and paper.” I rushed to get one, and as I sat beside him, he began listing names of his immediate family. He started with Marie, then said the names of his living daughters: Brielle, Mackenzie, his granddaughter’s were next, Avrielle and Sophia... and then once more, Marie again.

It touched me deeply with understanding because even in that fragile moment, his heart was still wrapped around the people he loved most. I asked, “What would you like me to write to them?” In that moment, he could only manage two words: “Tell them.”

Those were among the last clear words he ever spoke, and even then, his thoughts were with his family. His love for them, his devotion, and his concern never left. And even though he may have sprinkled fairy dust over everyone he met, I’ll always remember that day how even in his final moments, his thoughts were for his family. That was who he was: loving, unselfish, and so full of heart. His friendship is to be treasured by all who knew him.

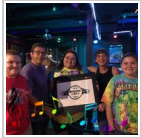
