



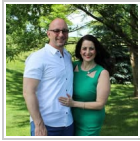
Laurie A. Galba

Laurie Ann Galba, 70, of Washington, MI, died Monday, 12-21-20, of COVID. She is survived by her beloved husband of 52 years, Jerome Galba Sr., her 4 children Jennifer, Sheri, Jerome, and Jason and their spouses, 11 grandchildren, 10 great grandchildren, Laurie's 3 sisters, and 2 brothers.

Laurie's life was focused on love for her Lord Jesus Christ, her husband, and family. She raised her children while partnering with her husband to build A & B Alarm Company. Together with Jerome, Laurie became a Chaplain with the Christian Motorcyclist Association, acting as a first responder, giving comfort and prayer support to secular motorcyclist club members at accident scenes, in hospitals, and funerals. She was a member of the Gospel Presenters, a group that shared our sins can be forgiven and God welcomes us into heaven because of Jesus' death on the cross. Laurie was an excellent musician, a member of the Detroit Metropolitan Flute Choir for many years. She played the flute and sang on the worship teams of several churches. Laurie devoted her time to being with her children, grandchildren, and family. She made family out of people she met, caring for people who crossed her path. Laurie enjoyed crocheting and cooking for others. Her sense of humor, kindness and love will not be forgotten. Due to the pandemic, Laurie will be laid to rest privately, at Utica Cemetery, in Shelby Township, MI. No memorial service is scheduled at this time. The family hopes to be able to hold a celebration of life at future date when it becomes safe to meet.
