Lawrence Edward Mitchum, a beloved husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, uncle, and friend, passed away peacefully on April 7, 2025, at the age of 89.

He was born on October 23, 1935, in Hickman, Kentucky, to Ruth and Bill Mitchum. Lawrence was a quiet, kind, and gentle man with a strong and unwavering faith in the Lord.

His faith was the cornerstone of his life, and he lovingly passed it on to his children and all who knew him. He and his wife, Virginia, found great joy serving their congregation at Christ Community Church in Sterling Heights, and he treasured his Sunday morning worship time.

Lawrence loved his work as a barber, serving his community for over 60 years.
