Lee Mathew Hercula, age 39, of Maryland, passed away November 1, 2019.

Born January 27, 1980 in Southfield, Michigan, Lee worked for the United States Government at Aberdeen Proving Ground as a Cyber Security Specialist and served in the US Army. Lee was known for a variety of achievements during his career as Captain in the United States Army such as running operations, serving as the network extension platoon leader, and working as Company Executive Officer for the Brigade. Lee won a multitude of awards for his service including two Meritorious Unit Commendations, five Army Commendation Medals, and the NATO Medal for exemplary service and performance during Operation Iraqi Freedom II and VII, among others.

Outside of work, Lee had many hobbies and will be remembered dearly for his sense of humor and love for playing chess, tennis and soccer. A passionate baseball fan, Lee loved the Detroit Tigers, but above all else Lee loved spending time with his family. Lee was kind and generous to everyone he met and was always there for everyone in his family. He was the best of us and will be dearly missed.

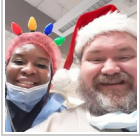
