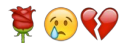
“ In the year of March of 1958 my late parents and myself moved to Tiffin Avenue Lee Roy was 13 and I was 16 at the time we became friends we would play records 45 rpms and we along with some of the other guys would sing along the record player was put outside and then we would sing. Of course those would be called golden oldies. One say Lee Roy we're walking down Hull Avenue going east and we seen dead snakes bull type because of the contruction company digging in the ground thus bring the snakes up in the very cold weather. He really got acided on this one, this include me too! Then on the way back we noticed smoke coming from the stilow on East Eucild the firemen just came back from a grass fire near by and we told them smoke is coming out of this building. The fireman said oh this isn't a fire it must be dust coming out just as he said this over radio came the fire call Junior and myself were right. That same fireman from old station # 7 on Hall avenve said you guys we're right and we just didn't listen you're right and we didn't listen. Lee Roy told his parents about this day's experiences. We had a lot of menories today. Oh yes I still remember them! The Wright family and some others I'll never ever forget. I'm going on 80 years old come nex year. 2021. Yes I miss all of them I almost got killed several times hard fullings into buildings.I have been in the rescure units both Des Moines and Pleasant Hill so many times I have lost count how many! I have asthma and on this one yep almost died. I currently have it undercontrol now. I take about 4 medications now. Just by chance Lee Roy's death came up on another sight. This is the only way I find out thing.Both Lee Roy Sr and Lee Roy Jr. came over to see both my late mother and myself on 1504 Tiffin Avenue which would be the last time would be to see the two of them. A sort time later 1986 my mother died of Congestive Heart failure at Iowa Lutheran Hospital . I'll never ever forget as I call it Tiffin Avenue the people, the times, the music and of course the neighbors! Thank you God in Heaven for all of this. If Lee Roy Jr was alive and I told him what I was he'd be some what surprised I became a Freemason like my late father was. I'll pray for Lee Roy along with his parents but (I already did after finding this information out. Thank you for reading this posting.
