I also remember a few trips we went on--to the Grand Hotel when Kelly was playing the violin there (and where she met Darryl), to Cleveland to hear Kelly play, to Cincinnati when Kelly was at school there. We also went to her mom's cottage with all the kids, and they came up north to our camper. We also had fun in their pool. She loved being a grandma and she would tell me cute things Hayden and Charlie would say. I told her my grandson is due to be born on her birthday, September 7. I hope he is. I wish we could have been grandmothers together. In addition to the intense love she had for her children, she had a deep, abiding love for Roger. I couldn't have asked for a better friend. I will miss her so much...
